- ACL, PCL, MCL, LCL repairs/injuries
- Tibial plateau fractures
- Osteochondral repairs
- Meniscal repairs
- Patella tendon repairs

The T Scope Premier Post-Op knee brace is designed to provide protected, controlled range-of-motion for patients recovering from knee surgery. The T-scope knee brace has a ROM hinge with quick-adjusting flexion and extension stops to control and limit knee flexion and extension. Stiff telescoping bars and overall brace design limits knee range of motion

This brace will be placed on you post-surgery and should be worn at all times, with the exception of showering.
