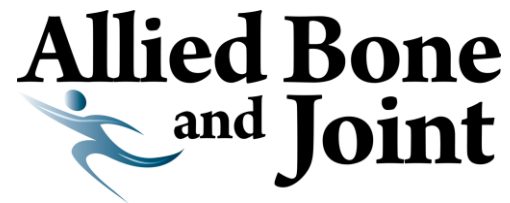


T-Scope Hip Brace

You are receiving the T-scope hip brace because you are having:

- Hip Arthroscopy
- Femular Acetabular Impingement (FAI)
- Hip labral repair and resection

The T-scope brace is designed to provide stability following your surgery. The brace has ROM hinge with quick-adjusting flexion and extension stops to control and limit hip flexion and extension. Stiff telescoping bars and overall brace design limits hip abduction and adduction. Semi-rigid cuffs help maintain control of the femur.

This brace will be placed on you post-surgery and should be worn at all times, with the exception of showering.
